## UTAH HOCKEY CLUB ULTIMATE FAN CONTEST OFFICIAL RULES

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY TO WIN. PURCHASE WILL NOT INCREASE THE ODDS OF WINNING.

Odds of winning will depend on the total number of entries received.

ELIGIBILITY: The Utah Hockey Club Ultimate Fan Contest ("Contest") is open to residents of the State of Utah who are 18 years of age or older at the time of entry. Employees of Sponsor, SEG Hockey, LLC ("Administrator") and NHL entities, and each of their respective parents, affiliates, subsidiaries, franchisees, retailers and advertising and sweepstakes agencies, as well as the immediate family (spouse, parents, siblings, children and each of their respective spouses, regardless of where they reside) and household members of each such employee, whether related or not, are not eligible to enter or win. Entrants are subject to all applicable federal, state and local laws and regulations. Void outside of Utah and where prohibited by law.

Administrator reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual it finds to be tampering with the entry process or the operation of the Contest or to be acting in violation of these Official Rules, or in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner and void all associated entries.

CONTEST PERIOD: The Contest begins at 12:00 a.m. Mountain Time ("MT") on March 1, 2025, and ends at 11:59 p.m. MT on March 31, 2025 (the "Sweepstakes Period"). Administrator's computer system clock will be understood as the official timekeeper of the Sweepstakes.

All submissions must be truthful, honest and follow the Entry Guidelines below. Entries received in excess of the above stated limitation from any person or email address will be void. All Entries become the property of Sponsor and will not be acknowledged or returned. Entries generated by script, macro or other automated means and entries by any means which subvert the entry process will be void. In the event of a dispute as to who submitted an Entry, the authorized account holder of the email address used to participate will be deemed to be the entrant and he/she must comply with these Official Rules. The "authorized account holder" is the natural person assigned an email

60% - Commitment of fandom to the sport of hockey and the Utah Hockey Club

In the first instance, ties will be broken based on the score for the first criteria. In the event of a further tie, the score for the second criteria will dictate. Finally, in the event of a further tie, the panel of judges will break the tie.

The entrant who submits the Entry that receives the highest score will be deemed the potential winner. Sponsor reserves the right to not award the prize if, in its sole discretion, it does not receive at least twenty-five (25) eligible and qualified entries.
